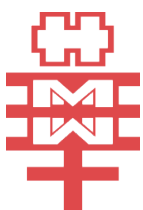
If you are looking for self-employment opportunities and interested in finding out more about setting up your own business, this workshop may be for you. The speaker Henry Chung will share:
